It has been a busy first week and we are pleased to see everyone back in school and are very pleased to meet the new Nursery and Reception children and parents.

Breakfast Club Reminders:

- Please make sure you only sign your children in for that day in the morning. A number of children are being signed in for the week on a Monday. As we use these registers for any fire procedures we need to know exactly who is in on that day.
- If you bring your children to school early in a morning on your way work please register them for Breakfast Club. We have a number of children left outside between 7-8am on their own waiting for 8.30am. It is better for them to be supervised in school, it only costs £2 per week for Breakfast Club. Ask at the office if you need a form.
- Breakfast Club doors shut at 8.15am. This allows us to prepare for the school day and for staff to be in class on time. It also allows us to ensure that the outside doors are shut when staff are no longer on duty downstairs.

Attendance

I have been asked to remind parents that as a school we are now following Leeds City Council procedures. Children must only miss school if they are ill or there are special circumstances which must be agreed by the Head Teacher. Holidays in term time will not be authorised and for safe guarding we need a completed form and proof of travel/booking. The school will refer any extended absences to the Local Authority and the procedures will be followed.
